



Longtime Professor Leon Unger Dies

Leon Unger, Ph.D., a longtime faculty member in the College of Medicine, died Oct. 24, 2017.

Unger came to the college in 1966 and stayed until his retirement in 2012. He loved teaching, and he designed significant portions of the biochemistry and molecular genetics course for medical, dental and pharmacy students. He won numerous awards, including the Aesculapian, the Edgar W. Young Lifetime Achievement Award, the Stanton L. Young Master Teacher Award, the OU Regents Professorship and several others. †
